_____ There are no extra spaces between each source.

_____ Sources are alphabetical in order

_____ Citations begin flush to the left. The second line of any entry is indented.

_____ Minimum 4 Sources are listed on the Works Cited. (The novel & three outside sources)

_____ Each source is formatted in correct MLA format (refer to formatting sheet given to you during the Seabiscuit lesson)

_____ All sources are credible (no Wikipedia, Blogs, EHow, web pages without credentials)

_____ The dates are in the correct format (February 15, 2013.)

_____ All book, magazine, and web page titles are in italics and NOT UNDERLINED

_____ Titles of web page articles are in quotation marks.

_____ Hyperlinks for web pages are provided

_____ There are appropriate periods/commas between the information and spaces between the periods.
